The logic for the NEGSURCHARGE setup option has been added to the Adjutant 20/20 platform:

1. Surcharges should be refunded when returning money. For example, if the surcharge is 3%, the refunding 100 should have a surcharge of - \$3 to return \$103 to the customer.

2. When invoicing from the sales order, the billmast.surcharge should only reflect the surcharges for that invoice. For example, if the total sales order is for \$1000 and two invoices are created: one for \$700 and another for \$300, both invoices currently have the same surcharge amount (if surcharge is %3 then both would have a surcharge of \$30). This change would assign a \$21 surcharge to the first invoice and a \$9 surcharge to the second one.

3. Add the billmast.surcharge field to the Customer Ledger report.
